

Set Permissions to secure your video content

Step 1 – Click *Permissions* to access the security features.

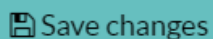

Step 2 – To ensure that your video content is only available to students enrolled in Brightspace, set the *Access Permissions* to:

- Non authenticated users - *NO*
- Authenticated users - *YES*
- Local users - *Untouched*

This ensures that only your students in Brightspace can access the video, it cannot be downloaded or shared outside of Brightspace.

Click *Save changes* to confirm.









Step 3 – If you want your video content to be available as an open link, available outside Brightspace, set the *Access Permissions* to:






- Non authenticated users - *YES*
- Authenticated users - *YES*
- Local users - *Untouched*

This ensures that your content can be viewed as an open link, users can view the video by using the link directly (e.g. provided by email).

Click *Save changes* to confirm.
